Downtown Tulsa Partnership is excited to launch the Spring season of the Downtown Tulsa Midweek Market Wednesday evenings from 4-7 PM at 600 S Main Street- Chapman Green- in Downtown Tulsa. We will work closely with interested vendors on accommodating unique needs.

Our primary goal is to bring fresh food offerings to the community; therefore, food vendors will be prioritized for booth space. Due to the high number of non-food vendor applications, non-food vendors will be rotated throughout the 10-week season to allow opportunities for everyone. **Once accepted to the market, you will be notified of all confirmed dates you are scheduled for the 10-week market season, the cost of your booth fees for the season, and information on how to submit payment.**

Applications are accepted year-round.

Booth Fees:

- Producers: \$15
 - Farmers, growers, ranchers, and producers of vegetables, fruits, herbs, meats, dairy, grains, nuts, fibers, eggs, honey, plants and flowers.
- Prepared Foods, Craft & Service Vendors: \$20

Guidance:

1. If you are an artist, entertainer, or instructor who wishes to provide free and open entertainment or programming (meaning no ticketed or admission fee for individual participants) at the market, please complete the “Entertainment Application” instead of this application.
2. It is a vendor’s responsibility to know what permits, licenses, and certificates are required to sell their product, and all must be current and valid.
3. If you are an alcohol vendor, you must have your valid ABLE commission license to sell the product according to its required format, i.e., ready-to-consume beverages vs. sealed beverages. DTP will hold a permit for alcohol sales and consumption in the park during the hours of the event.
4. Vendors are required to bring all the equipment they need to successfully vend their product, including tables, tents, and generators.
 - a. If using a tent, tent weights will be required. Weights must be no less than 20 lbs. per tent leg.
5. Please reference the Downtown Tulsa Midweek Market Guidelines available at downtowntulsa.com/market.
